Very curling and ruffled, this is a Cascade but also measures as a true spider. Pod and pollen fertile. Sunfast, delicate scapes. (Planet Max x Brer Rabbits Baby).

ANNABELLE'S GHOST - \$17 - Reinke, '95 - 34" M 8" dor.dip. Spider. Clear lavender spider with cream apricot throat

APACHE WAR DANCE - \$15 - Thomas, Dale, 1994 30" MLre 4.5" Dor Tet Frag, Noc. Ext. Scarlet Red, darker eye, great hot late color. Destined to be a classic. Excellent parent for late tets. Not many late tets are this good.

ASHWOOD STILL NIGHT - \$20 - Norris, R., 2004 28" ERE 5.25" SEV Tet Dark Purple self with great branching. Blooms a long time, hardy, carefree.

ASIATIC PHEASANT - \$8 - Knowler, '73 - 22" M 6" dor.dip. UF Crinkly edge, gold yellow with lighter edge, late

AUTUMN MINARET - \$8 - Stout, '51 - 66" Mla-Vla 4" dor.dip. Extremely tall, very well branched, high performance, orange/yellow

BLOWING BUBBLES - \$125 - (Murphy, 2010) 42 MRe 7.5dormant diploid ext.fr. 3 branches, 31 buds. Lavender with a blue-ish watermark, cream midrib and edge; Diamond dusted. Unusual form pinched crispate. Very sunfast, fertile, and an excellent parent. Won best seedling in the region 3 Hybridizers bed 2009. (Seedling x Far Galaxies)

BO KNOWS - \$10 - Bennett, F., '01 - 22" M 4" dor.dip. Light rose with eye and edge, green throat, from Dragon's Eye.

BRER RABBIT'S BABY - \$15 - Roberts, Ned '02 - 30" M 5" sev.dip.frag. Uf Black red self, curly

CATCH THE SPIRIT - \$8 - Santa Lucia 2000 38" Mre 7" Dor Dip UF Rusty Rose Blend dark rose edge. Blooms forever, with bud building and rebloom. Vic selected this one for performance!

CHAMA VALLEY - \$14 - Hansen, Dan '00 - 24" EERe 6.5' sev.tet. Uf Soft amber reverse bitone/violet eye

CHEATING HEART - \$10 - Bennett, F., '92 - 22" M 5.5" semi.dip. Gorgeous rose red, round flat .form

CHIEF BLACK HAND - Display Only - Warrell '98 - 36" Mla 6.5" dor.dip.ext. uf Black Red self

CHIEF FOUR FINGERS - \$18 - Roberts, N. 2002 44" M 6" SEV Dip EXT Polymerous Dark red purple with black eye. Excellent parent for polys.

CHOKECHERRY MOUNTAIN - \$20 - Roberts, '02 - 34" M 8" semi. Dip UF dark wine red with dark purple eye, reblooms well

CITRINA VESPERTINA - \$10 - species - 60" M 3" dor.noc. Yellow trumpet self, very fragrant



COMPASS ROSE - \$75 - (Reed, 2010) 40 La 5 dormant diploid. 4 branches, 24 buds. You cant get lost going in this direction. A late bloomer, Compass Rose starts 4-5 weeks after midseason, like its parent, After Awhile Crocodile. Light rose with a darker rose band, yellow-cream throat. (After Awhile Crocodile x seedling)

CRICKET CALL - Display Only - Roberts, Ned '04 - 33" M 7" sev.dip. UF Wine purple, long blooming August

DAZZLE THEM - \$10 - Bennett, F., '98 - 21" EM 3.5" sev.dip. Round rose/red little one

DELICATE ONE - \$55 - Reinke, 2006 38" ML 7" Dev Dip Frag 20% Polytepal Yellow with halo, green throat. Near spider. Margo and I have both been very impressed with this plant. Easy, long blooming and consistent.

DREAM CATCHER - \$18 - Roberts, Ned '95 - 36" Mla 10" dor.dip. Spider Rose bronze blend very large

EARLIANNA - \$8 - Betscher '38 - 24" Ere dor.dip.frag.ext. Very early cute yellow orange trumpets.

EIGHT DAYS A WEEK - Display Only - Sayers, Pat '04 - 30" Mla 7" sev. Dip. polytepal rounded pink blend, sometimes double

FANCIFUL FINERY - \$8 - Kirchoff, '84 - 15" EERe ev.dip.frag. Amber blend double with pink highlights, blooms 3 times here.

FIRE FROM HEAVEN - \$8 - Grovenstein, '85 - 28" M 5.5" dor.tet. Bright, sunfast, narrow red tet. Good parent, great plant

FIRESTORM - \$8 - Krekler, '79 - 31' EM 8.25" dor.dip. UF Brick red with gold throat, good parent

FLAMBOYANT PROMISE - \$15 - Thomas, '99 - 32" La 6" sev.tet. UF distinctive orange rose, late blooming

FLAMBOYANT VAMP - \$8 - Lunsford, '93 - 24" E 12" dor.dip. Rose pink self with cream throat.

FLEUR DE ROCAILLE - \$8 - Whitacre, '88 - 30" M 4" dor.dip. Spider. Blueish pink and yellow bitone, red and cream eye.



FOCUS - \$100 - (Murphy, 2010) 39MLa7dormant diploid ext.fr.3 branches, 23 buds. Black purple with a black band, chartreuse throat, and ruffled edges; diamond dusted. Unusually sunfast for a dark color and a sea of blooms in the late season. Fertile. (Dont Know Jack x Chief Black Hand)

FOL DE ROL - \$8 - Connell, '54 - 40" Mla 7" ev.dip. Spider Brown-yellow blend, chevron eye, classic antique, still good

FOREST LAKE RAGAMUFFIN - Display Only - Harding, '93 - 28 EMRe 5.5" dor.tet Pink with gorgeous gold ruffle, excellent parent

FOX EARS - \$10 - Roberts, N. 2002 40" ML 8" SEV Dip Frag. Ext. UF Very different purple bitone, that blooms for a long time. Unusual Unusual Form.

FREEWHEELING - \$25 - Stamile, P. 2004 34" EERE 9" EV Tet Spider Huge Cream Yellow Burgundy Red Eye, Choice. This cultivar appears to be completely hardy here, showing no winter damage. Truly excellent parent, difficult pods.

GOLLIWOG - \$10 - Wild, '83 - 23" Mla 8.25" dor.dip. UF Pink cream yellow blend, spatulate UF, HM.

GRAPEFRUIT GUTS - \$10 - Millhorn, '98 - 26" EM 3" dor.dip. Polytepal Pale grapefruit yellow, high percentage polytepal

GREAT RED DRAGON - \$75 - Gossard, J, 2006 41" EM 10" Dor Dip Spider Striking red spider with shocking green throat. Won Peoples Choice at the Richmond Area Daylily Society Show in 09. Proliferates, good parent.

H. CITRINA - \$10 - God or Darwin! 50" M 4" Dor Dip near spider. Cute yellow trumpets, strongly nocturnal, blooms 2 months, very very fragrant. Very hard dormant, going down in September here, and coming up in April.

HEAVENLY CURLS - \$25 - Gossard, '00 - 27" M 7" dor.dip. Uf Near white self, excellent breeder

H. FLAVA - \$8 - (species) - 20" EE 4" dor.dip. The 1st daylily to bloom here, hardy, lemon yellow.

HOLLY DANCER - \$8 - Warrell '88 - 32" M 7" dor.dip. Ext. Spider Clear brilliant red spider

HUMMINGBIRD - \$8 - Benesch-Sh. '55 - 30" M 3" dor.dip. Deep ruby red little self, green throat, well branched,

HUSH LITTLE BABY - \$8 - Sikes, '92 - 22" Mla Re 5" dor.dip. Small deep rose pink blend.

INDIAN GIVER - \$8 - Ferguson, '91 - 20" EMRe 4.5" semi.dip. Purple, darker watermark, white edge, fast grower. HM, AM.

JOHN R. PIKE - \$40 - Doorakian '04 - 32" M 6.25" dor.dip. Uf polytepal lavender yellowgreen blend

JULY FOUR - \$8 - Wynn, 63 - 32" EMRe 6" dor.dip. Brilliant red with plum eye, award winner

KAREN'S CURLS - \$10 - Reinke, '97 - 31" M 7" dor.dip. UF fragrant Lavender/cream bitone

LAVENDER ARROWHEAD - \$15 - Stamile, '99 - 36" EMRe 9" ev.tet.frag. Monster lavender with chartreuse watermark, eye, UF.

LET LOOSE - \$15 - Stamile, P. '03 - 36" EERe 9.5" Ev. Tet. Very fragrant, UF Lemon yellow self

LOBO LUCY - \$15 - Roberts, '97 - 35" M 7" semi.dip. Ext. spider Brilliant red spider

LOCH NESS MONSTER - \$15 - Couturier, '92 - 25" M 7.5" dor.dip.spider Ruffled silvery lavender with lighter edge, darker halo. Great.

LOLA BRANHAM - \$20 - Burkey, '91 - 38" Mla 7.5" dor.dip. Cream/lavender blend, cascade unusual form

LOVELY PINK LADY - \$20 - Harris, John '02 - 24" EMRe 7" sev.dip. Unusual form - cascade, Soft pink with darker eye and edge This plant blooms EM, with instant rebloom, and then sits for a month until blooming all through late summer and fall in our climate. I hear that it does this in the Northeast US as well.

MONKEY SEE MONKEY DO - \$20 - Dickerson, '02 - 18" E 3" dor.tet. Pink with cherry eye, green throat great rebloomer

MOONLIT ENCORE - \$30 - Clement '06 - 34" Ere 5.5" sev.tet. Round cream, dark purple eye, reblooms, very hardy

ORCHID LADYSLIPPER - Sold Out - Branham '79 - 36 EM 5.5" Dor dip Orchid with cream edges, yellow green throat, Lambert breeding.



PALE ALE - \$125 - (Murphy, 2010) 44MLa7dormant diploid ext.fr.3 branches, 24 buds. Light pink and stippled cream with a light green throat and ruffled edge. Unusual form cascade, that blooms for many weeks into the very late season. 100% sunfast; fertile. (Margo Reed Indeedx Heavenly Curls)

PANCAKE PLATYPUS - \$20 - Baxter '02 - 24" Ere 6.25" Ev dip Polytepal Yellow with raised midribs. High % polytepal, fertile.

PANDA BEAR - \$10 - Stamile, '98 - 25" M Re 5" dor.tet.frag. Round yellow with bold wine eye, slight edge.

PANIC IN DETROIT - \$25 - Adams, Rick '02 - 40" Mla 8" dor.tet.frag. Reddish orange with white midribs, showy

PASSING FANCY - \$10 - Bennett, F., '00 - 25" Mre 6" dor.dip. Rose, with red band, yellow green throat, performance plus. Pretty.

POINT OF VIEW - \$10 - Roberts, S. '92 - 35" EMRe 7.5" dor.tet.ext. Deep Signal Red self, very showy on strong scapes

QUEEN MOTHER MEMORIAL - \$15 - Dickerson, '02 - 24" E 7" dor.dip. Purple with orchid edge, green throat

RADIANT MOONBEAM - \$9 - Larch, '78 - 36" Mla 6.5" semi.dip. Classic near white self, excellent parent for spidery whites.

RAINBOW TOWERS - \$15 - Schwarz '99 - 64' M 8" dor.tet. Very tall bright gold, long bloom



RESONATE - \$100 - (Murphy, 2010) 40E8semi-evergreen tetraploid, ext. 2 branches, 15 buds. Extra large reddish lavender with purple veins, chartreuse throat and yellow midribs with a narrow cream edge, diamond dusted. On cool mornings this flower starts purple. Sunfast, fertile. Tet (Cameroon Night x Waiting in the Wings)

RIBBONETTE - Display Only - Lenington, '51 - 24" M 5" dor.dip. Striking red with white edge bitone, recurved, extreme branching

ROYAL JESTER - Display Only - Kennedy +, '91 - 24" Late 6" dor.dip.frag. Strawberry/cream bicolor, very ruffled, very late, good branching

RUBY SPIDER - \$10 - Stamile, '91 - 34" E 9" dor.tet. Huge red show-stopper, yellow throat. UF- spatulate. - HM, AM,

RUFFLED VINTAGE BURGUNDY - \$15 - Krupien, '92 - 30" M 3.5" dor.dip. High-performing dark burgundy purple, darker eye, cute small.



SALAMANDER FEATHERS - \$100 - (Reed, 2010) 36EM5dormant diploid ext.4 branches, 20 buds. An early small gem on well-branched scapes.Soft pink lavender with feathery purple chevronslike gills, lighter ruffled edges, and green to white throat.Unusual Form cascade. (Flight ofOrchids x Loch Ness Monster)

SANDRA ELIZABETH - \$8 - Stevens ,'83 - 38" V1a 6" dor.tet. The standard for late bloom and high performance. Yellow. HM, EFA

SEARS TOWER - Display Only - Goldner, '00 - 72" M 7" dor.tet fragrant, ext. Very tall yellow polychrome

SIR BLACKSTEM - Display Only - Hager, '88 - 24" Ere 2.5" ever.dip. Yellow/brown bicolor, black stems!
