FOCUS - \$65 - (Murphy, 2010) 39MLa7dormant diploid ext.fr.3 branches, 23 buds. Black purple with a black band, chartreuse throat, and ruffled edges;diamond dusted.Unusually sunfast for a dark color and a seaof blooms in the late season. Fertile. (Dont Know Jack x Chief Black Hand) The only cultivar with this parentage, and an excellent parent. Hard Dormant

JULIA UHEY - \$20 - Kropf '93 28" MRE 5.5" Dormant Diploid Double Fragrant Cream layered double with dark pink eye and yellow green throat. In Kropf Layered Double Collection



MISS ELLENEOUS - \$25 - (Reed, 09) 50 MLa 8 dor.dip.ext. Unusual Form pinched crispate (very consistent). Large, late, tall, and pinkish. This bloom has size, form, substance, presence, and personality. The color is muted pink, with a large yellow-cream throat (green deep in the throat). The sepals quill and curl and the petals are ruffled. Parentage unknown, this has been a favorite garden flower for the late season for some time. Scapes are erect and the bud count is just adequate (around 12). Difficult pod parent. Really nice dancing in the late garden! It is a bud builder still in bloom at the end of August. Actual budcount is higher with good culture. Special Price- it grows fast!

MY FRIEND LIZ - \$30 - Trego '06 35" VL 5.5" Dormant Tetraploid Fragrant Rose pink white midrib, yellow throat. 3 branches, 17 buds. Out of SANDRA ELIZABETH. Not many VL dormant tets in the gene

pool!



PEAK EXPERIENCE - \$40 - (Reed, 2010) 56MLa8dormant diploid
Named after my cat, Peak, and my love of mountains, this tall daylily is commanding. The garden name has been Tall, late, silvery lavender pink which says it all. It is a very large bloom, outfacing, and the cool pale pink is set off with a cream applique throat color/watermark. Special Price- Fast Grower.



ROCKET SCIENCE - \$15 - Murphy, '05 - 38" Mla 6.5" dor.dip.
Outrageous clear lemon, radical UF, green throat. This has proven perfectly hardy in both zones 3 and 9 (west). One of my favorites because it is always perfect, every day, with excellent budcount and growth. Out of SUNNY SON by SPIDER MIRACLE. Fertile, proliferates, fragrant. This outrageous clear light yellow to chartreuse flower is a radically shaped crispate unusual form. It is quite variable as well. It has a large grass green throat with very ruffled, lighter edged petals. The sepals are so rolled that you can't see the edge. It has three branches and 17 buds, with instant rebloom, for a long season. It proliferates heavily. It is dormant, and has famous parentage, carrying genes for ruffled edges, red, chartreuse, and yellow, ensuring that it will be in demand by hybridizers. Parentage: SUNNY SON X SPIDER MIRACLE



YORKTOWN BEACH - \$30 - (Reed, 2010) 38MLa6.5dormant diploid.3 branches, 18 buds. Pink blend from gold throat through yellow, cream, and peach peach pink giving a warm, tropical summer delight. Named after a beach near the Chesapeake Bay. Near-spider, Pod and pollenfertile. Special Price- Grows Fast!

ZADA MAE - \$15 - Kropf '82 22" M 4.5" Dormant Diploid Double Light Peach self, tiny green throat, layered double. Excellent plant, excellent parent. In Kropf Layered Double Collection

ZELLA VIRGINIA - \$15 - Kropf '82 24" MRE 5.5" Dormant Diploid Double Cantaloupe self layered double with green throat. Reliable rebloomer for us and taller than most doubles here. Excellent parent.
