APPALACHIAN TRAIL - Display Only - (Reed, 2010)32EM6dormant, diploid Richest rose pink, with a green throat, this bloom presents itself nicely. On the hottest days, it becomes a lighter rose pink, but holds up perfectly. Its strength is the scape, which is usually 3 or 4-way branched and holds the blooms apart. A beautiful Blue Ridge rose with lots of ruffles. Pod and pollen fertile.



BUZZER BEATER - Sold Out - (Murphy, 2010)40M8dormant diploid, extended This huge grey-lavender with feathered purple eye has a lemon throat. Grey on cold mornings, more lavender on warm days. Fertile both ways, out of DEVILS ADVOCATE X GREY WITCH. Excellent grower. Extra large 8 blooms, two branches with 18 buds.



CHIPMUNK - \$75 - (Reed, 2010)40M4dormant diploid Cute as a chipmunk, this little brown spidery bloom has a black stripe (eye) and green throat. It is tall, well-branched, and has lots of bloom. Not quite a miniature or a true spider, it has potential in that direction. It is out of REUTHERS BROWN SPIDER x BROWN WITCH, which gives it a heritage of vigor and pod fertility.



COLDBEAR RAPPORT - \$100 - (Murphy, 2010)40MRe7 semi-evergreen, diploid, extended, Unusual Form - Cascade This reddish-lavender cascade has muted purple and slate patterned eyezones. A reliable re-bloomer here with 2 branches, 15 buds, fertile. Out of YABBA DABBA DOO X LOLA BRANHAM.



HORSEPOWER - \$100 - (Murphy, 2010)44La7dormant, diploid, extended, fragrant Unusual Form-Cascade This lavender pink cascade with chartreuse and apricot throat has cream midribs and a thin cream edge. The spectacular part of this plant is below the blooms. It has blue-green foliage, strong scapes, 5-way branching, 31 buds per scape. It is out of MARGO REED INDEED X NORTHWIND DANCER. It is very fertile, and a good parent for clear colors.



ICE WATER - Sold Out - (Reed, 2007)36M6.5dormant diploidUnusual Form-Cascade I was so excited when this bloomed that I registered it immediately.I was sure it would be an introduction.After a couple of years of letting it multiply, it is ready!The bloom is a pale-lavender, almost translucent, white.The throat is cream.It presents as a very curly cascade, on 4- and 5-way branched scapes.I have seen as many as 6 blooms open on one scape.It is different from so many flat whites, in that it looks carved out of ice.Pod and pollen fertile. One of my best.



PEAK EXPERIENCE - \$75 - (Reed, 2010)56MLa8dormant diploid Named after my cat, Peak, and my love of mountains, this tall daylily is commanding.The garden name has been Tall, late, silvery lavender pink which says it all.It is a very large bloom, outfacing, and the cool pale pink is set off with a cream appliqu throat color/watermark.



REDSKIN WALKER - \$125 - (Murphy, 2010)39EMRe10semievergreen, diploid extended, EMO, Spider This absolutely huge, curly red spider has a chartreuse throat.It has two branches, 17 buds, and a long bloom season. Pollen fertile, it is out of BRILLIANT IDEA X KIRSTEN MADELINE BURKEY.



SHELBY - \$100 - (Reed, 2010)38M6dormant, diploidUnusual Form-Cascade This stunning pink/rose/cream pattern is a curling cascade form.Named in memory of a young girl, a town in North Carolina, or a race car designer;I guess well never know (or all three). The background color ranges from a creamy pink to almost white, and the dark rose-pink eye slips way out on the petals.It has a green throat.It is out of PEACOCK CURLS X HEAVENLY CURLS, a cross that has given many interesting variations. Pod and pollen fertile.



SPORTS COUPE - \$125 - (Murphy, 2010)36MLa7.5dormant, diploid, extended, fragrant.Unusual Form cascade. This clear, light pink and cream cascade with a ruffled edge has a long bloom season. It has four-way branching, 27 buds, lots of proliferations, blue-green foliage, and it is 100% sunfast.On hot days it becomes cream colored.Out of MARGO REED INDEED X NORTH WIND DANCER, it is fertile both ways.



ZERO TO SIXTY - \$100 - (Murphy, 2010)48M9semi-evergreen, diploid, extended, spider. This gorgeous, sun-fast, tall purple spider has a lemon throat and cream midribs. It has very stiff and strong scapes, 3 branches and 22 buds. It is out of GREY WITCH X BLACK ICE. Pollen fertile.
